Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 855 Cantrell St is a two-story single-family house built about 1890, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. It presents an irregular plan. The building has a cross-gabled roof. The internal brick chimney has a corbelled cap. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Porch feature(s) include the following: turned wood posts. The only ancillary building on the property is a garage.
