Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 507 W Jefferson St is a two-story single-family house built in 1910, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. The house exhibits architectural elements typical of the National Folk tradition, a domestic architectural expression that utilized building materials that could be purchased at lumberyards supplied by the growing railroad network in Texas during the nineteenth and early twentieth centuries. The center-passage plan features a central hallway that is flanked with one room on either side, a plan type that was popular in Texas through the early twentieth century. The building has a hipped roof. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The building has a single-door primary entrance with wood framing. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: columns.
