Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 813 W Main St is a one-story single-family house built about 1890, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. With its elaborate exterior detailing and use of varying textures and materials, the building is indicative of the Queen Anne style, which was popular during the late nineteenth century. It has an L-shaped plan with a front-projecting wing on the front facade. The building has a cross-gabled roof. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The primary entrance is a single doorway with wood framing and other other similar entries. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: turned wood posts, jigsaw trim, spindlework trim. Landscape feature(s) include the following: walkways.
