**Architectural Description**

**General Architectural Description:**

The building at 320 E Marvin Ave is a two-story single-family house built about 1905, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. The house displays features that are associated with the Folk Victorian style, a domestic architectural expression that relied on the use of applied architectural ornamentation on more traditional house forms. It presents an irregular plan. The building has a cross-gabled roof. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Door feature(s) include the following: transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: turned wood posts, jigsawn trim. A secondary back house is at the rear of the lot.
