Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 407 E Marvin Ave is a one-story single-family house built about 1920, as estimated by field personnel based on its physical characteristics. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. It displays features associated with the Craftsman movement, which was popularized in magazines and pattern books from the early- to mid-twentieth century. Its plan is indicative of a bungalow, a domestic house form that was popular from the 1910s to the 1930s. The building has a front-gabled roof. The building has a brick external chimney. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Porch feature(s) include the following: tapered wood box columns. A secondary back house is at the rear of the lot.
