Architectural Description

General Architectural Description:

The building at 603 N Rogers St is a two-story single-family house built in 1904, according to the historical marker associated with the property. The property was originally built for residential purposes, and its use remains unchanged. The primary exterior material is wood. Its footprint presents a square-shaped plan and hipped roof, a distinctive house form of the early twentieth century. The internal chimney is constructed of brick. The windows are double-hung with wood sashes. The single-door primary entrance has a wood doorway and frame. Door feature(s) include the following: sidelights, transoms. Porch feature(s) include the following: classical columns. The only ancillary building on the property is a garage.
